# Our Rooms

All rooms are individually furnished to a high standard with a unique colour scheme and comprise either double or twin beds. Each of our rooms has en-suite bath and shower (some with separate shower cubicle), colour television, direct dial telephone and refreshments tray.

## Standard Rooms

Well-proportioned rooms on the rear or side of the hotel with views over Fowey.

## Select Rooms

We have many different styles of Select rooms; some of our newly refurbished Selects are more compact than others in this category. All enjoy sea and estuary views across the river to Polruan.

## Premier Rooms

These are our larger and better-located rooms in the hotel, providing sea and estuary views across the river to Polruan. Our most luxurious rooms have four-poster or king-size beds, bathrobes and mineral water.

## Premier Plus Rooms

The *Rebecca Suite* is decorated with a romantic theme, has a Four-Poster bed and enjoys an expanse of windows and balcony with stunning river views.

The *Readymoney Suite* is a spacious room with a large bay window overlooking the estuary mouth. It is decorated with rich fabrics and has a Four-Poster bed.

The *Riverbank Suite* has a bedroom and lounge area both with TV and windows with stunning sea views; the spacious bedroom boasts a balcony and king-size bed. All Premier Plus rooms have DVD players.

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# Children

When sharing a room with two adults, children between the ages of 4 and 8 will be charged £15 per child per night, and aged 9 to 14 will be charged £25 per child per night; this is inclusive of breakfast. Children aged 14 and over are charged at the full adult rate. Unfortunately, children under the age of 14 years are not permitted to occupy rooms without an adult. Children under 4 requiring a cot or a z-bed will be charged £5 per night.

High teas are served in the lounge between 5 pm and 6.30 pm. For children eating in the restaurant reservations are available at 6.30 or 6.45, there is a minimum charge of £15.

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# Car Parking

The car parking at the hotel is very limited. We charge £10 per night to park at the hotel; disabled spaces (if available) are free of charge. To avoid disappointment we advise booking prior to arrival. Spaces vary in size and large cars do struggle to fit in some of the smaller spaces; please let us know the make and model of your car when reserving parking. Once all our spaces are reserved the nearest parking is in the pay and display public car park situated on Hanson Drive. This is about 3 minutes by car from the hotel or 7 minutes walk. On arrival you are welcome to stop at the hotel where reception will help you to unload your luggage before directing you to the car park. We provide a free shuttle service and a valet parking service at a charge of £5.00 per return trip (both available during daytime hours). If you wish to park at the hotel we recommend booking at your earliest convenience to avoid disappointment.

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# Dogs & Pets

Dogs and other non-exotic pets are welcome by arrangement at a charge of £7.50 per night, excluding food. Pets are welcome in the guest rooms only and not in public areas.

# Dining At the Fowey Hotel

The Fowey Hotel has held the coveted AA rosette award for food since 1997. We offer a gourmet menu as part of our dinner, bed and breakfast package; this changes quarterly and makes full use of the best of seasonally available Cornish produce, in addition on a daily basis, we introduce new and exciting dishes. Should you have a specific dietary requirement or would like any dishes to be prepared or cooked in a plainer style the Restaurant team will be more than happy to assist you.

*Our Gourmet menu is £35 per person but if you book it prior to arrival then it can be added to your tariff for £25 per person.*

When the hotel is at its busiest our dining room is unable to cater for all our guests in the evening. This means that if you have made a reservation on a bed and breakfast basis we cannot guarantee that you will be able to dine with us in the restaurant. If you have made a reservation inclusive of dinner and would like to eat at a specific time we recommend booking early. Most guests prefer to eat between 7pm and 8pm and therefore these booking times are filled early. The views from the restaurant are spectacular and many guests request a window table; however we only have 4 of these available. We do not reserve tables and they are allocated on a first come first served basis. If you would like one of these you are more likely to be seated at one if you book early (6.30pm) or later (8.30pm – 9pm). We also offer an excellent bistro style menu, which is available in the bar, lounge areas and also in your room or in fine weather on the balcony!

Breakfast is served between 7:30 and 10:00am daily. The most popular time is between 8:30 and 9:30am. If you choose to take breakfast during these times please be aware that you may not be seated immediately.

Smart casual attire is requested in our restaurant. We respectfully request no shorts or training shoes.

We would like to assure you that we take pride in all we do and the rules we follow are set out in order that we provide all our guests with the best possible service.

## Cancellations

All bookings require a deposit of £50 per person, which can be paid with a debit or credit card. The full balance for your stay is payable on arrival. If you cancel less than 28 days prior to arrival the deposit will be retained and you may be liable for the full cost of your holiday. If you cancel more than 28 days before your arrival there is an administration charge of £5.

No allowances can be made for meals not taken, or for rooms not occupied for the full period of the booking. We advise arranging cancellation insurance. Please ask for details of our policy.

Lanhydrock House is one the most visited National Trust properties, dating from the 17<sup>th</sup> century but largely rebuilt after a fire in 1881. An atmospheric Victorian country house set in 900 acres of woods and parkland.
